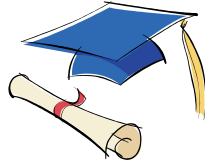

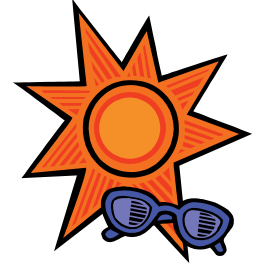
Summer has arrived...

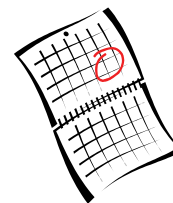

Tuesday, August 24 and runs until **Friday, September 17.**

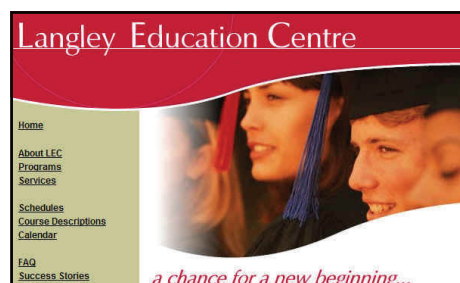
Important Registration Information:

- Register early to ensure your seat in the course(s) that you need.
- Be prepared to purchase texts at the time of registration (cash, debit, Visa, Mastercard, AmEx).
- If you are not a graduated student (from a Canadian high school), you will need to call ahead to book a counselling appointment before you can register.
- New registrants: When registering, please bring the following:
 - BC Photo ID
 - High school transcript or report card
 - Proof of name change (if applicable)
 - Immigration papers (if applicable)
 - Permission to Enroll form (if applicable)
- Cost:
 - A \$10 parking pass is required if you plan on parking at LEC while attending class(es).
 - \$15 student fee
 - \$30 materials fee for adults
 - Fees are not refundable after the registration period
- Start dates:
 - Semestered & blended courses begin September 8 & 9.
 - Directed Learning courses begin September 13.

District Dual Credit Programs

Dual Credit Program Changes

Budget and staffing reductions have necessitated a re-structuring within our Careers & Transitions Department. Unfortunately, we are no longer able to support student access to the same number of Dual Credit Programs as we have in the past. We will be offering the following dual credit programs for the 2010 – 2011 school year:

- four in-District ACE IT programs (Piping, Auto, Carpentry, Hair)
- BCIT Electrical, Kwantlen Horticulture and Kwantlen Metal Fabrication.

The following programs will no longer be offered to our students for the 2010-2011 school year: RCABC Roofing; UFV Aircraft Structures; VCC Baking and Pastry; Kwantlen Welding; Kwantlen Millwright; and Kwantlen Masonry.

We are disappointed about these program losses, but it's our intention to continue to provide the best student support possible given the budget and staff time available.
